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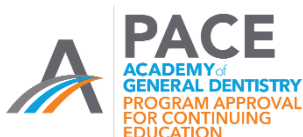

He is the current Accreditation Chair of the American Board of Cosmetic Dentistry. Dr. Lotardo has published multiple articles and lectures internationally on Smile Design, Cosmetic Dentistry and Restorative Driven Orthodontics.

Ensuring that your restorative cases are optimized for success takes a multidisciplinary approach. The educator will share concepts and strategies utilizing orthodontics combined with esthetic, restorative and implant principles that are critical for minimally invasive, predictable and excellent outcomes.

- ◆ Analyze elements of smile design that tie together restorative and orthodontic criteria.
- ◆ Learn how various tooth movements can improve chances for delivering low risk and predictable esthetic outcomes.
- ◆ Identify case types that would benefit from a multidisciplinary approach.
- ◆ Learn a system for managing missing laterals to ensure your patients' esthetic goals are achieved.
- ◆ Understand how to use hopeless teeth to improve implant success.
- ◆ Learn how to treat adult occlusal issues effectively and predictably with proper diagnosis and orthodontic intervention.

**Course Breakdown:** Since many of our members attend various portions of the weekend on an individual basis the following protocol has been developed to allow the allocation of credits to accurately reflect seminar attendance.

**Case Diagnosis:** At the heart of our organization has been the evaluation of each other's cases to enhance clinical skills. Accurate records serve as a basis for accurate orthodontic case diagnosis by each dental practitioner.

Orthodontic records include:

1. trimmed orthodontic study models,
2. accurate photographs with proper retraction (occlusal shots taken with mirrors and flipped for proper display),
3. orthodontic clinical exam (includes TMD evaluation),
4. panoramic radiograph,
5. cephalometric radiograph,
6. cephalometric tracing.

The above protocol follows the standard of care for those dental practitioners providing orthodontic services for their patients in the United States. **All course attendees are encouraged to bring cases to case diagnosis with the above records so that we may all provide input into each other's cases.**
